Lady Royals Set to Host Salisbury in Non-Conference Action

►The University of Scranton women's basketball team looks for a seventh straight win as they welcome Salisbury to the John Long Center for a non-conference matchup on Tuesday afternoon.

All-Time Series vs. Salisbury

►This marks just the second all-time meeting between the two programs and the first since a 109-64 Lady Royals victory on Nov. 23, 1991.

- DiPillo is in his third season at the helm of the Lady Royals and led the program to their sixth straight Landmark Conference championship with a 56-55 victory over Catholic on Mar. 6, 2021
- Guard Bridget Monaghan earned WBCA Honorable Mention All-American honors in 2021
- Lady Royals scored 100 points for first time since Dec 30, 2004 in 100-44 win vs. Rosemont (Dec. 21, 2019)
- DiPillo earned his first win at Scranton with a victory at Ursinus on Nov. 15, 2020
- Spent five seasons as an assistant coach and a Director of Player Development at Seton Hall University
- Helped guide the Pirates to a 94-66 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances
- Coached eight All-Big East Conference selections and two WBCA All-Americans
- Served as a Skills Trainer/Camp Director at the Monroe Sports Center
- Has also served as an assistant coach of the New York Liberty in the WNBA where he coached three All-Stars and three Olympians

- Scranton put together a dominant first half and led 30-5 in the late stages of the second quarter before eventually taking a 34-7 lead into the locker room.
- Graduate student **Abby Anderson** led four Lady Royals in double figures with 15 points and was joined by 12 points from junior **Hannah Angelini** and 11 apiece from sophomore **Maddie Hartnett** and senior **Emily Shurina**.
- Angelini has scored in double figures in three of her last four games and is averaging 11.8 points per game during that stretch.

Last Time Out: Salisbury

►Tuesday will mark Salisbury's first game since January 8 when they came away victorious by a score of 64-47 over Ursinus. The Sea Gulls were able to force 25 Bears turnovers in the win and pulled away in the second half for the 17-point victory. Scoring wise, Kaylee Otlowski led four Salisbury players in double figures with a game-high 16 points, while Lauren Fortescue added 10 points, six assists and six steals.

Shurina Leads Lady Royals to 3-0 Week

►Shurina averaged 11.0 points and 9.7 rebounds per game in three contests last week as she helped lead Scranton to victories over Clarks Summit, Susquehanna and Goucher. The East Meadow, N.Y., native put together a 15 point and career-high 14 rebound performance in Wednesday's win at Susquehanna as her 14 boards surpassed her previous career-high of 10 that had been set in consecutive wins over Juniata on Feb. 26 & 27, 2021.

Anderson on a Scoring Tear

• Anderson has scored 20 plus points on six occasions this season including in four of her last eight games. In those eight contests, Anderson is averaging 19.1 points per game and 11.1 rebounds. She set a new career-high with 27 point performances in victories over TCNJ (Dec. 22) and Juniata (Jan. 8).

Lady Royals News & Notes

►In an abbreviated 2020-21 season due to COVID-19, the Lady Royals went 7-1 against all Landmark Conference foes and won the program's sixth straight conference title as they defeated Catholic in the title game for a second straight year.

- Scranton has captured a total of nine Landmark Conference titles and 27 total conference championships in program history.

Salisbury News & Notes

►The Sea Gulls have ripped off 10 straight wins entering play on Tuesday after starting the season 2-2. One of their two losses on the season came against Catholic in a 66-51 setback on Nov. 16.

- Otlowski (14.7 ppg) and Fortescue (14.4 ppg) lead the way offensively for Salisbury, while Otlowski is also the team's top rebounder at 9.1 boards per game. Otlowski also shoots 54.9% from the floor.
- The Sea Gulls as a team shoot 42.8% from the floor and average 13.0 steals per game.
